

Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric

Fabric A, cut:

- (1) 3½" x WOF; subcut (3) 3½" x 6½" pieces
 - (2) 3½" squares

Fabric B, cut:

(3) 3½" x WOF; subcut (15) 3½" x 6½" pieces (1) 3½" square

Fabric C, cut:

(3) 3½" x WOF; subcut (14) 3½" x 6½" pieces (1) 3½" square

Fabric D, cut:

(4) 3½" x WOF; subcut (20) 3½" x 6½" pieces (4) 3½" squares

Fabric E, cut:

(4) 3½" x WOF; subcut (19) 3½" x 6½" pieces (2) 3½" squares

Fabric F, cut:

(8) 21/2" x WOF for binding

Fabrics G and H, cut from each:

(3) 61/2" x WOF for borders

Fabric I, cut:

- (2) 3½" x WOF; subcut
 - (8) 3½" x 6½" pieces
 - (1) 3½" square

Fabric J, fussy cut:

(4) 6½" squares with motifs centered NOTE: Motifs will vary due to the cut of the fabric.

Fabric J- Cut (4) 6 1/2" squares, with motifs centered



Fabrics K and O, cut from each:

(3) 3½" x WOF; subcut (17) 3½" x 6½" pieces (2) 3½" squares

Fabric L, cut:

(3) 3½" x WOF; subcut (16) 3½" x 6½" pieces (1) 3½" square

Fabric M, cut:

(3) 3½" x WOF; subcut (15) 3½" x 6½" pieces (2) 3½" squares

Fabric N, cut:

- (2) 3½" x WOF; subcut (9) 3½" x 6½" pieces
 - (1) 3½" square

Fabric P, cut:

(3) 3½" x WOF; subcut (17) 3½" x 6½" pieces (1) 3½" square



Instructions

Note: Use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout. Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even using matching thread. Press after each seam.

Quilt Top Assembly

- 1. Noting the **Quilt Layout** diagram (page 5), arrange all 3½" x 6½" rectangles and 3½" squares in 20 rows, making sure to orient the squares with directional prints so they match the orientation of the rectangles.
- 2. Sew the rectangles and squares into rows. Sew rows together to complete the quilt center (54½" x 60½" unfinished).
- 3. Sew all the **Fabric G** 6½" WOF strips together end to end and cut into (1) 60½" long left side border and (1) 54½" long bottom border.
- **4.** Repeat with the **Fabric H** strips to make a right side and a top border.
- 5. Sew the **Fabric G** 60½" border to left side of the quilt center and the **Fabric H** 60½" border to the right side of quilt center.
- 6. Sew a Fabric J 6½" square to each end of the Fabric G and H 6½" x 54½" borders. Add the Fabric H border to top and the Fabric G border to bottom of quilt.

Finishing

- 7. Sew together the 2½" **Fabric F** binding strips end-to-end using diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
- **8.** Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
- 9. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew the binding to the top of the quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to ¼" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
- **10.** Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.





Quilt Layout
