

# **Additional Recommendations**

- 100% cotton thread in colors to match
- 74" x 90" (1.88m x 2.29m) batting

### Cutting

#### WOF = Width of Fabric

Note: Label cut pieces with letter identifier for easier assembly.

#### Fabric A, cut:

(8) 5½" x WOF for outer borders
(9) 4½" x WOF; subcut

- (3) 41/2" x 241/2" rectangles
- (4) 41/2" x 201/2" rectangles
- (4) 41/2" x 161/2" rectangles
- (4) 41/2" x 121/2" rectangles
- (4) 41/2" x 81/2" rectangles
- (3) 41/2" x 41/2" rectangles

### Fabric B, cut:

(11) 41/2" x WOF; trim each to 41/2" x 421/2"

#### Fabric C, cut:

(8) 21/2" x WOF for binding

# Fabric D, cut:

(7) 11/2" x WOF

**Fabrics E through I, cut from each:** (4)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

# Sewing

**Note:** All seam allowances are ¼" (.64cm) unless otherwise noted. Sew pieces right sides together. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

- Arrange the 4½" x 42½" Fabric B rectangles in a single horizontal row, orienting the rectangles as they were in the original uncut yardage. Referring to the Quilt Layout (page 4) for sizes, place one 4½" Fabric A rectangle above, and another below, each Fabric B rectangle. Sew the rectangles in each vertical row together along adjacent edges. Press.
- Sew (2) 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF Fabric E strips together end to end. Make (2) pairs of joined strips. Press. Cut (2) sashing strips measuring 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 70<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>". Repeat with 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF Fabrics F through I strips to make (2) 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 70<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" sashing strips of each fabric.
- **3.** Arrange the step 1 units in a single horizontal row again, ordering the **Fabric B** rectangles as they appeared in the original yardage. Referring to the **Quilt Layout** (page 4) for color placement, place a step 2 strip between each step 1 unit. Sew the step 1 and step 2 units together along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances toward the step 2 units.
- 4. Sew the 1½" x WOF Fabric D strips together end to end. Press. Cut (2) inner side borders, 1½" x 70½", and (2) inner top/bottom borders, 1½" x 56½". Sew one inner side border to either side of the quilt center. Press the seam allowances toward the border. Sew one top/bottom border to the upper edge, and the other to the lower edge of the quilt center. Press the seam allowances toward the border.
- 5. Sew the 5½" x WOF Fabric A outer border strips together end to end. Press. Cut (2) side borders, 5½" x 72½", and (2) top/bottom borders, 5½" x 66½". Sew one side border to either side of the quilt center. Press the seam allowances toward the border. Sew one top/bottom border to the upper edge, and the other to the lower edge of the quilt center to complete the quilt top. Press the seam allowances toward the border.

## Finishing

- 6. Sew together the (8) 2½" x WOF (6.35cm x WOF) Fabric C binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
- Trim the selvage edges from the backing fabric. Cut the yardage into two equal lengths and use a ½" (1.27cm) seam to sew the sections together along one long edge to make the quilt backing. Press.
- 8. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the quilt top after quilting is completed.
- 9. Leaving an 8" (20.32cm) tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" (30.48cm) from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, right sides together. Trim seam to ¼" (.64cm) and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
