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## Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric

#### Fabrics A and B, cut:

Fussy cut (5) 8" squares with motifs centered

**Fabrics C-F, I-N, S, U, and V, cut:** (1) 8" x WOF; subcut (2) 8" squares

### Fabrics O-R, cut:

(1) 5" x WOF; subcut (5) 5" x 8"

#### **Fabric T, cut:** (9) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF (binding)

Fabric W, cut: (15) 3" x WOF; subcut (200) 3" squares (38) 2" x WOF; subcut (180) 2" x 5" (40) 2" x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" (220) 2" squares Fabrics X and AF, cut:
(4) 2" x WOF; subcut (71) 2" squares
Fabrics Z and AC-AE, cut:
(3) 2" x WOF; subcut (46) 2" squares

Fabrics Y, AA, and AB, cut: (3) 2" x WOF; subcut (45) 2" squares

#### Instructions

**Note:** Use a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seam allowance throughout. Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even using matching thread.


#### **Block Assembly**

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all **Fabric W** 3" squares. Fig. 1






2. Arrange 4 marked Fabric W 3" squares right sides together on corners of a Fabric A 8" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>". Press corners out to complete 1 Block 1a (8" square unfinished). Fig. 2



In the same manner, make a total of 5 each Blocks 1a and 1b and 2 3. each Blocks 1c-1q with fabrics indicated. Fig. 3







4. Arrange 2 marked Fabric W 3" squares right sides together on corners of a Fabric Q 5" x 8" piece as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>". Press corners out to complete 1 Block 2a (5" x 8" unfinished). Fig. 4





**5.** In the same manner, make a total of 5 each Blocks 2a-2d with fabrics indicated (5" x 8" unfinished). **Fig. 5** 




6. Arrange 5 Fabric AF and 4 Fabric W 2" squares in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete 9-patch unit (5" square unfinished). Fig. 6



Arrange 9-patch unit, 4 Fabric AF 2" squares, and 4 Fabric W 2" x 5" pieces in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete 1 Block 3a (8" square unfinished). Fig. 7

**8.** Referring to Steps 6 and 7, make the number of Blocks 3a-3i listed with fabrics indicated (8" square unfinished). **Fig. 8** 




9. Arrange 5 Fabric AF 2" squares, 3 Fabric W 2" squares, 2 Fabric W 2" x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" pieces, and 1 Fabric W 2" x 5" piece in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete 1 Block 4a. Fig. 9



 In the same manner, make a total of 4 each Blocks 4a and 4f and 2 each Blocks 4b-4e with fabrics indicated (5" x 8" unfinished). Fig. 10



 Arrange 3 Fabric AF 2" squares, 2 Fabric W 2" squares, and 2 Fabric W 2" x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" pieces in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 2 Block 5a (5" square unfinished). Fig. 11



12. In the same manner, make a total of 2 Block 5b with fabrics indicated.Fig. 12Fig. 12


## **Quilt Top Assembly**

**13.** Noting **Quilt Layout** (page 8) arrange all blocks into 11 rows. Sew into rows. Stitch rows together to complete quilt top (77" square unfinished).

## Finishing

- **14.** Cut and piece the backing to measure 85" x 85". Layer the backing right side down, batting, and quilt top right side up. Quilt or tie as desired.
- **15.** Prepare binding from (9) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF **Fabric T** strips. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together.
- **16.** Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.
- **17.** Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
- **18.** Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.

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
