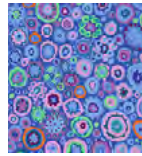

Fabric Requirements

DESIGN	COLOR	ITEM ID	YARDAGE
(H) Paperweight	Blue	PWGP020.BLUEX	$\frac{3}{4}$ yard (0.69m)
(I) Curly Kale	Blue	PWPJ120.BLUE	$\frac{5}{8}$ yard (0.57m)

Additional Requirements

- Kaffe Fassett Collective 100% cotton Aurifil thread 50wt.

Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric

HST = Half-square Triangle

From Fabric H, cut:

(4) $5\frac{3}{8}$ "* x WOF; subcut

(24) $5\frac{3}{8}$ "* squares, then cut in half diagonally once to yield 48 HSTs

**If desired, size up strips and squares by $\frac{1}{8}$ ", then trim completed units to size listed.*

From Fabric I, cut:

(4) 4" x WOF; subcut

(32) 4" squares, then cut in half diagonally once to yield 64 HSTs

We are almost there! We are creating two more blocks this time. Are you getting closer to solving this beautiful mystery?

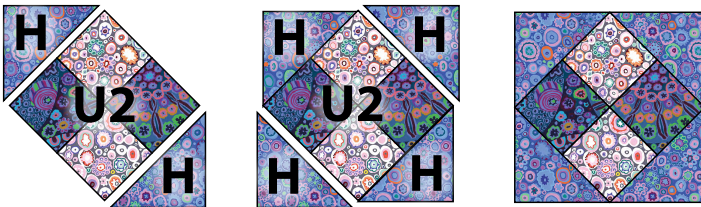
Instructions

Notes:

- Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance throughout. Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even using matching thread. Press after each seam.
- Unit numbers will remain the same from puzzle to puzzle, so be sure to label units as you complete them and keep them grouped together by number to stay organized for the next puzzle. Label and keep completed blocks together by number as well.

1. Sew 2 **Fabric H** $5\frac{3}{8}$ " HSTs to opposite sides of a **Unit 2** - Puzzle 1. Add 2 more **Fabric H** $5\frac{3}{8}$ " HSTs to the remaining sides of **Unit 2** to complete a block. Make a total of 12 **Block 3** ($9\frac{1}{2}$ " square unfinished). **Fig. 16**

2. Stitch the long side of a **Fabric I** 4" HST to the top of a **Unit 7** - Puzzle 3 as shown. Make a total of 64 **Unit 10** ($7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{4}$ " unfinished). **Fig. 17**

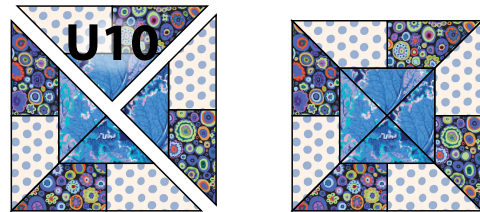

3. Arrange 4 of **Unit 10** as shown. Stitch units together in pairs, then sew paired units together to complete a block. Make a total of 16 **Block 4**. **Fig. 18**
