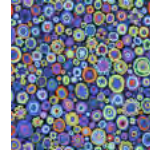


# Cathedral Tiles Mystery Quilt - Delft

## PUZZLE 4

### Fabric Requirements

DESIGN	COLOR	ITEM ID	YARDAGE
(K) Paperweight	Cobalt	GP20.COBLT	¾ yard (0.69m)

### Additional Requirements

- Kaffe Fasset Collective 100% cotton Aurifil thread 50wt.
- **Optional:** square rotary cutting ruler, at least 7", with eighth-inch markings

### Cutting

- **From Fabric K, cut:** (9) 2½" x WOF for binding and hold for Puzzle 7

## PUZZLE 4

If you are asking how all these disparate pieces fit together, then you'll be happy to be finishing a block in this puzzle. You'll be using units you've already made.

### Instructions

#### Notes:

- Use a ¼" seam allowance throughout. Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even using matching thread. Press after each seam.
- Unit numbers will remain the same from puzzle to puzzle, so be sure to label units as you complete them and keep them grouped together by number to stay organized for the next puzzle. Label and keep completed blocks together by number as well.

1. From each **Unit 5** - Puzzle 2, cut (2) segments 3¾" wide for a total of 40 of **Unit 8**. **Fig. 11**

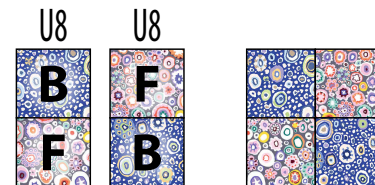

2. Sew 2 of **Unit 8** together, alternating fabrics, to make a four-patch. Centering seams, trim to 6⅞" square (unfinished). Make a total of 20 **Unit 9**. **Fig. 12**

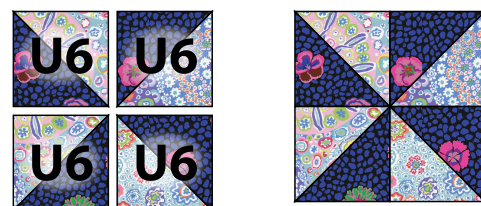

3. Arrange 4 of **Unit 6** - Puzzle 3 in 2 rows of 2 as shown. Stitch units into rows. Sew rows together to complete a block. Make a total of 8 **Block 2** (9½" square unfinished). **Fig. 13**
