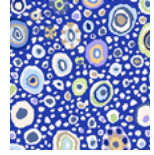

Fabric Requirements

DESIGN	COLOR	ITEM ID	YARDAGE
(B) Roman Glass	Blue and White	GP01.BLWH	½ yard (0.46m)

Additional Requirements

- Kaffe Fassett Collective 100% cotton Aurifil thread 50wt.

Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric
HST = Half-square Triangle

From Fabric B, cut:

- (2) 5⅜" * x WOF; subcut
- (10) 5⅜" * squares, then cut in half diagonally once to yield 20 HSTs
- *If desired, size up strips and squares by ⅛", then trim completed units to size listed.*

PUZZLE 5

You'll finish two more puzzle blocks this time. Will it be enough to solve the mystery?

Instructions

Note:

- Use a ¼" seam allowance throughout. Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even using matching thread. Press after each seam.
- Unit numbers will remain the same from puzzle to puzzle, so be sure to label units as you complete them and keep them grouped together by number to stay organized for the next puzzle. Label and keep completed blocks together by number as well.

1. Sew 2 **Fabric B** 5⅜" HSTs to opposite sides of a **Unit 4** - Puzzle 2. Add 2 more **Fabric B** 5⅜" HSTs to the remaining sides of the unit to complete a block. Make a total of 5 **Block 1** (9½" square unfinished).

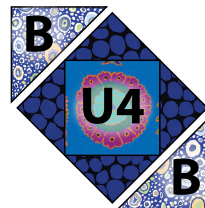
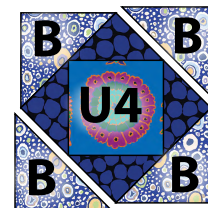
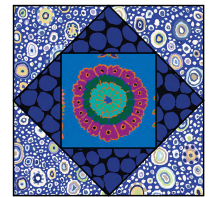

Block 1 - Make 5



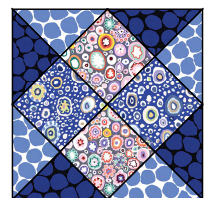
2. Sew 2 **Unit 3** - Puzzle 1 to opposite sides of a **Unit 9** - Puzzle 4. Add 2 more of **Unit 3** to the remaining sides of **Unit 9** to complete a block. Make a total of 20 **Block 5** (9½" square unfinished).
