Kaffe Fassett Collective 100% cotton Aurifil thread 50wt.

Cutting

Fabric V, cut:

(9) 2¹/₂" x WOF pieces for binding and hold for Puzzle 7

If you are asking how all these disparate pieces fit together, then you'll be happy to be finishing a block this puzzle. You'll be using units you've already made.

Instructions

Notes:

- Use a ¹/₄" seam allowance throughout. Sew all pieces • with right sides together and raw edges even using matching thread. Press after each seam.
- Unit numbers will remain the same from puzzle to • puzzle, so be sure to label units as you complete them and keep them grouped together by number to stay organized for the next puzzle. Label and keep completed blocks together by number as well.
- 1. From each Unit 5a, cut (2) 3³/₄" wide Unit 8a for a total of 20 Unit 8a. In the same manner, cut 20 Unit 8b from Units 5b. Fig. 11
