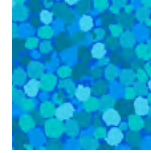

- Kaffe Fasset Collective 100% cotton Aurifil thread 50wt.

Cutting

Fabric V, cut:

(9) 2½" x WOF pieces for binding and hold for Puzzle 7

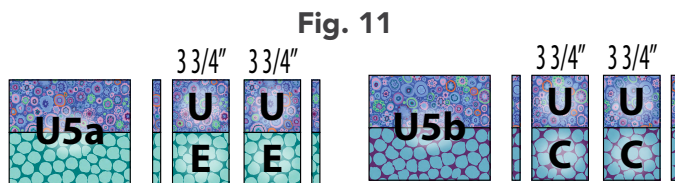
If you are asking how all these disparate pieces fit together, then you'll be happy to be finishing a block this puzzle. You'll be using units you've already made.

Instructions

Notes:

- Use a ¼" seam allowance throughout. Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even using matching thread. Press after each seam.
- Unit numbers will remain the same from puzzle to puzzle, so be sure to label units as you complete them and keep them grouped together by number to stay organized for the next puzzle. Label and keep completed blocks together by number as well.

- From each **Unit 5a**, cut (2) 3¾" wide **Unit 8a** for a total of 20 **Unit 8a**. In the same manner, cut 20 **Unit 8b** from **Units 5b**. **Fig. 11**

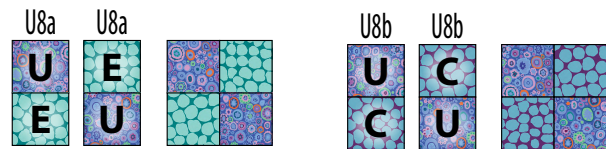


Cut 20 - Unit 8a

- Sew 2 **Unit 8a** together, alternating fabrics. Centering seams, trim to 6⅞" square (unfinished). Make a total of 10 **Unit 9a**. In the same manner, make 10 **Unit 9b** each with 2 **Unit 8b**. **Fig. 12**

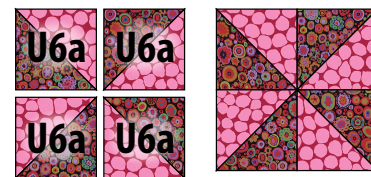


Unit 9a - Make 10

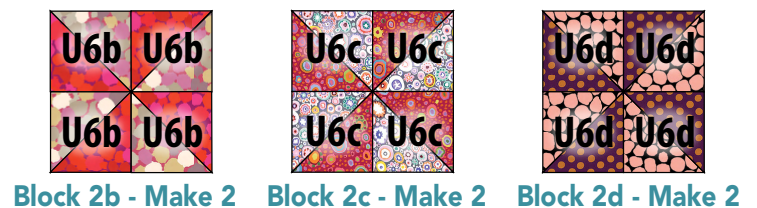
Unit 9b - Make 10

- Arrange 4 **Unit 6a** - Puzzle 3 in 2 rows as shown. Stitch units into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 2 **Block 2a**. In the same manner, make 2 each **Blocks 2b-2d** with units indicated using puzzle 3 units. (9½" square unfinished). **Fig. 13**
