

PUZZLE 2 Fabric Requirements

DESIGN	COLOR	ITEM ID	YARDAGE
(A) Guinea Flower	Pink	GP59.PINK	¼ yard (0.23m)
(B) Paperweight	Purple	GP20.PURPL	¼ yard (0.23m)
(C) Jumble	Duck Egg	PWBM053.DUCKE	½ yard (0.46m)
(D) Spot	Peacock	PWGP070.PEACO	¼ yard (0.23m)
(E) Jumble	Turquoise	PWBM053.TURQU	½ yard (0.46m)
(F) Jumble	Blue	PWBM053.BLUEX	¼ yard (0.23m)
(U) Paperweight	Blue	PWGP020.BLUEX	5∕8 yard (0.57m)



Additional Requirements

• Kaffe Fassett Collective 100% cotton Aurifil thread 50wt.

Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric HST = Half-square Triangle

From Fabric A, cut:

(1) 5" square

From Fabric B, cut:

- (1) 4¹/₈"* x WOF; subcut
 - (2) 41/8"* squares, then cut in half diagonally once to yield 4 HSTs

From Fabrics C and E, cut from each:

- (1) 5" x WOF; subcut (2) 5" squares (2) 3¾" x WOF
 - (2) 3¾" x WOF

Fabrics D and F, cut from each:

(1) 41/8"* x WOF; subcut

(4) 4¹/₈"* squares, then cut in half diagonally once to yield 8 HSTs each (16 total) *If desired, size up strips and squares by ¹/₈", then trim completed units to size listed.

From Fabric U, cut:

(4) 3¾" x WOF

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PUZZLE 2

In this puzzle you will be creating with more beautiful Kaffe Fassett fabrics. The mystery continues as you cut, sew and construct. Be sure to keep your units labeled and neatly organized.

Instructions


Notes:

- Use a ¼" seam allowance throughout. Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even using matching thread. Press after each seam.
- Unit numbers will remain the same from puzzle to puzzle, so be sure to label units as you complete them and keep them grouped together by number to stay organized for the next puzzle.
- Sew 2 Fabric B 4¹/₈" HSTs to opposite sides of a Fabric A 5" square. If desired, trim dog ears even with raw edges of the center square. Add 2 remaining Fabric B 4¹/₈" HSTs to remaining sides of the unit to complete 1 of Unit 4a (6⁷/₈" square unfinished). If needed, sliver trim to size. Fig. 4




Unit 4a - Make 1

2. In the same manner as step 1, make 2 each Units 4b and 4c with fabrics indicated. Fig. 5




Stitch 1 each Fabrics E and U 3³/₄" x WOF strips together lengthwise. Press seam allowance towards Fabric U. Make sure the strip set measures 7" high, including seam allowance. Make a total of 2 E/U strip sets. From the strip sets, cut a total of 10 segments 8" wide. Label these Unit 5a. In the same manner, make 2 C/U strip sets and cut 10 segments 8" wide for Unit 5b.
