## Cutting

**WOF = Width of Fabric**, cut from selvage to selvage

**Fabrics A, B, D – L, and N – P, cut from each:** (1) 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF; subcut (4) 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares

**Fabric C, cut:** (10) 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF; subcut (60) 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares

### Fabric M, cut:

(1) 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF; subcut
(4) 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares
(8) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF for binding

## Instructions

Use a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seam allowance throughout. Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even using matching thread.

## **Quilt Top Assembly**

- Arrange all the 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares into 12 rows of 10 as shown in the **Quilt Layout** diagram, Page 4, alternating 5 **Fabric C** squares with 5 squares of the other prints in each row, following the quilt layout diagram or creating your own arrangement of prints.
- 2. Sew the squares into rows, backstitching at top of seams of the top row and bottom of seams in the bottom row (backstitching prevents the outer edges of seams from opening up while the quilt top is being assembled). Press away from **Fabric C**.
- **3.** Sew rows together, backstitching at both ends of seams. Press all seams in the same direction.

## Finishing

- **4.** Sew together the 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" **Fabric M** binding strips end-to-end using diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
- 5. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
- 6. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew the binding to the top of the quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
- **7.** Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
